All Breed Performance Events Entry Information

All entries in the Performance Classes must be at least 6 months of age or older on the day of the show and be ASCA® registered, or apply and pay for an ASCA Tracking Number. You may be asked to show proof of registration. **No Bitches In Season in Rally**

***No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from any ASCA program; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Please remember to include Jump Heights on Open/Utility entries and Rally entries. Junior Obedience Exhibitors be sure to note “JUNIOR” on your entry form!*

Bitches in Season: may run in Scent Detection. They must be kenneled and pottied in an area away from others, wear pants and run last, and the competitor should contact the Trial host seventy-two hours in advance if they anticipate their dog will be in season

**** All non-ASCA® registered dogs will be required to have an ASCA® Tracking Number if you wish to earn ASCA titles. This is a one-time fee of \$20.00 per dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA® member (Service member fee-\$20.00).** ASCA® membership does not need to be maintain in subsequent years. You will be able to apply for a tracking number the day of the show, if your dog does not have one. **Link to forms:**

From the north or east, I-96/696 to Orchard Lake Road, south 4 miles, including the jog
at Grand River, continuing on Orchard Lake Road to building on the east side (Orchard
Lake Trade Center);

From the south, I-96 to Merriman Road, north 3 miles to Seven Mile Road. Turn right
and go to Merriman Rd and make a left. Just past Eight Mile Road, where Merriman
changes to Orchard Lake Road, pass two buildings to Orchard Lake Trade Center on
the right; from the west, I-275 to Eight Mile Road east five miles to Merriman/Orchard
Lake Road, turn left, second building on the right (Orchard Lake Trade Center). Club is
at the beginning of the building.
